NEW EDUCATIONAL ERA OF UNIVERSITY

Junagadh Agricultural University has started two new colleges and four poly techniques for human resource development in different human activities.

1. Agribusiness Management College (ABM)



It is the post graduate college of its kind in the field of Agribusiness Management in Saurashtra region of Gujarat.

2. College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry

Another college namely college Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry is also started from July-2008. It is first in Saurashtra and third in Gujarat state. The admission procedure is through common entrance test.

The College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry is all poised to take up the challenges of the animal husbandry activities of the Saurashtra region, guarding the animal health, providing all required health care facility to the precious animal wealth of the Saurashtra, providing disease diagnostic facilities and Veterinary services to the farmers and dairy animal keepers. Thus, preserving health of animals and preventing epidemic also.

The College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry, Junagadh has the unique advantage of having origin and home tract of precious *Gir* Cattle, *Jaffrabadi* buffalo, *Kathiyawadi* horses and Asiatic Lion. All these species are available for study to the students of B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree which is an rare opportunity available any where in the country for the Veterinary students of the other Veterinary Colleges.

3. Up gradation of Agril. School and New Poly Technique Colleges

The JAU has upgraded the Agricultural Diploma Schools to poly technique colleges in Agriculture & Horticulture. In this programme, the poly technique in Horticulture is located at Junagadh and the poly technique in Agricultural science at Dhari.

Other two new poly technique colleges like poly technique in Agro processing at Junagadh and poly technique in Home Science at Amreli will also start from the 2009 academic year. The admission process is finished for all the college.
