Shri Naval Kishore Sharma, Chancellor & Governor of Gujarat state offers degrees and medals to the students at 2nd Annual convocation

The 2nd convocation of Junagadh Agricultural University was held on Feb. 2, 2007. Hon. Governor and Chancellor Shri Naval Kishore Sharmaji presided over the function. Shri Bhupendrasinh Chudasama Minister of Agriculture & Cooperation, Gujarat state delivered the convocation address.

Total thirty seven gold plated silver medals were conferred to outstanding and brilliant students. Mr. Ajay Singh, a student of College of Agriculture received thunderous applause by bagging 13 medals.

H.E. Shri Navalkishor Sharmaii said that agricultural universities have to play major role in agricultural development. Education is root of social development. He advised students to develop spirit of entrepreneurship and be "employment giver" rather than "employment seeker" by sheer hard work.

Shri Bhupendrasinh Chudasama, Hon. Minister of Agriculture & Cooperation, Gujarat narrated in detail the various steps taken by the Govt. of Gujarat to promote agriculture sector in the state. This is reflected in the gain in 12 percent growth rate for agriculture by state. He highlighted the success story of Krushi Mahotsav. Farmers also became aware about resources and technologies. He congratulated the scientists of University for success of Krushi Mahotsav - 2005 and 2006 which are the trend setter as they provided insight to farmers about the agricultural technologies and resources available to them. He also urged the scientists to focus their attention on the areas like value addition, soil and water conservation, qualitative improvement in horticulture crops production of high quality seeds.

Dr. B. K. Kikani, the Vice Chancellor gave an account of progress of University in the fields of education, research and extension. He informed that since the establishment of JAU, university has conferred 299 Bachelor degrees, 222 Master degrees and 64 Ph.D. degrees in the discipline of Agriculture, Agricultural Engineering & Technology and Fisheries. Total 249 students (177 in person and 72 absentia) received their degrees during this convocation.

Shri Mohanbhai Patel, Ex Minister of Irrigation, Guiarat state relived the long association he had with University specially advised the students to be visionary in their approach.

ISAE convention & symposium organized at JAU, Junagadh

The 41st ISAE Convention and Symposium of Indian Society Agricultural Engineers was organized by College of Agricultural Engineering and Technology, JAU, Junagadh during January 29-31, 2007.

The function was inaugurated by Shri R. B. Jain. Director(Technic al), Jain Irrigation Systems Pvt. Ltd, Jalgaon who was the chief guest of the function.

Prof. A. C. Pandya, Ex Director, CIAE, Bhopal; Dr. B. K. Kikani, Vice Chancellor, JAU were the guest of Honour, and Dr. Nawab Ali, President, ISAE and Deputy Director General (Engg), ICAR, New Delhi presided over the function. Dr. Jain in his inaugural speech said that the pace of agricultural growth has to be accelerated if the overall economy has to grow at the targeted rate. Dr Nawab Ali stressed on the need for doing research in the areas like energy management, efficient utilization of agricultural machinery and equipments, water management, post harvest processing & value addition.Dr. B. K. Kikani stated that agriculture contributes 20 percent of Net State Domestic Products (NSDP) in Gujarat. Even the doubling the food production is on top in Government's priority list which requires an average rate of 7.18 percent annual food production.

250 participants (scientists, agricultural engineers, technocrats, industrialists and farmers) from all over the country participated. Theme papers in the field of Process Engineering, Farm power & Machinery, Soil & Water Engineering and Energy in Agriculture were presented and discussed. Scientists were awarded and honoured for their outstanding achievements in Agricultural Engineering.

Research Recommendations

1. **Agricultural Residues Shredder** has been developed by the Department of Farm Machinery & Power which is operated with 6 hp diesel engine shreds plant stalks of castor, cotton



and pigeon pea. The capacity is about 170 to 190 kg/hr, making pieces of 10 to 75 mm length. The volume of

shredded material reduces by about 80 percent. Thus, the value addition of about 50 to 80 percent can be made in the use of agricultural residues. The machine is recommended for the use of farmers, manufacturers and industries.

 The Agrucultural Research Station (Fruit), Mahuva is involved in developing



improved varities of fruit crops. Recently the centre has developed the Hybrid Coconut varitey T x D (Mahuva) with more desirable characters like early and heavy bearing, higher yield, greater nut size and kernel weight than the ealier varieties viz. West Coast Tall and

Dwarf Green. It can be the replacement of the West Coast Tall and Dwarf Green coconut varieties and alternative to existing Hybrid D x T (Mahuva).

Demonstration: The demonstration trials were conducted on farmers' field during 2002-2006. It was observed that for effective management of root-knot nematodes (*M. arenaria*) in groundnut



crop the application of carbofuran @ $2 \, kg \, a.i.$ / ha with castor cake @ $1000 \, kg$ /ha prior to seeding i.e. before 2-3 days was found to be very effective.
